EDWARD KELLY MEMORIAL TROPHY (no additional fee).

Open to all placers in Preliminary and Open Champ competitions. All competitors will dance hard shoe treble reel, 1 step down the line 2x. The winner will receive the Memorial Trophy and a \$50 Scholarship Award. Trophy must be returned the following year engraved with winner's name. Emerald Feis is always the 3rd full weekend in May.

I-684N to I-84W to exit 19 (Home Depot). Turn right from I-84 E or W onto Rt 312, proceed straight ahead to traffic light on Rt 6 (approx. 1.5 mi), turn right and proceed straight ahead past McDonalds, Putnam Plaza and up the hill to Rt 52, Carmel. Lake Gleneida will be in front of you. Turn right onto Rt 52, past St. James Catholic Church to traffic light. Turn left onto Rt 301. Follow 301 across the causeway, turn right on Gypsy Trail Rd. Feis is 1 mile on your right.
